This warm and sunny oasis is home to the San Diego Zoo, SeaWorld, and Legoland, which are all perfect spots for children of all ages. Make sure to check out the Historic Old Town Area, with buildings from the early 1800s, and the Gaslamp quarter, with restaurants and shopping opportunities galore.
