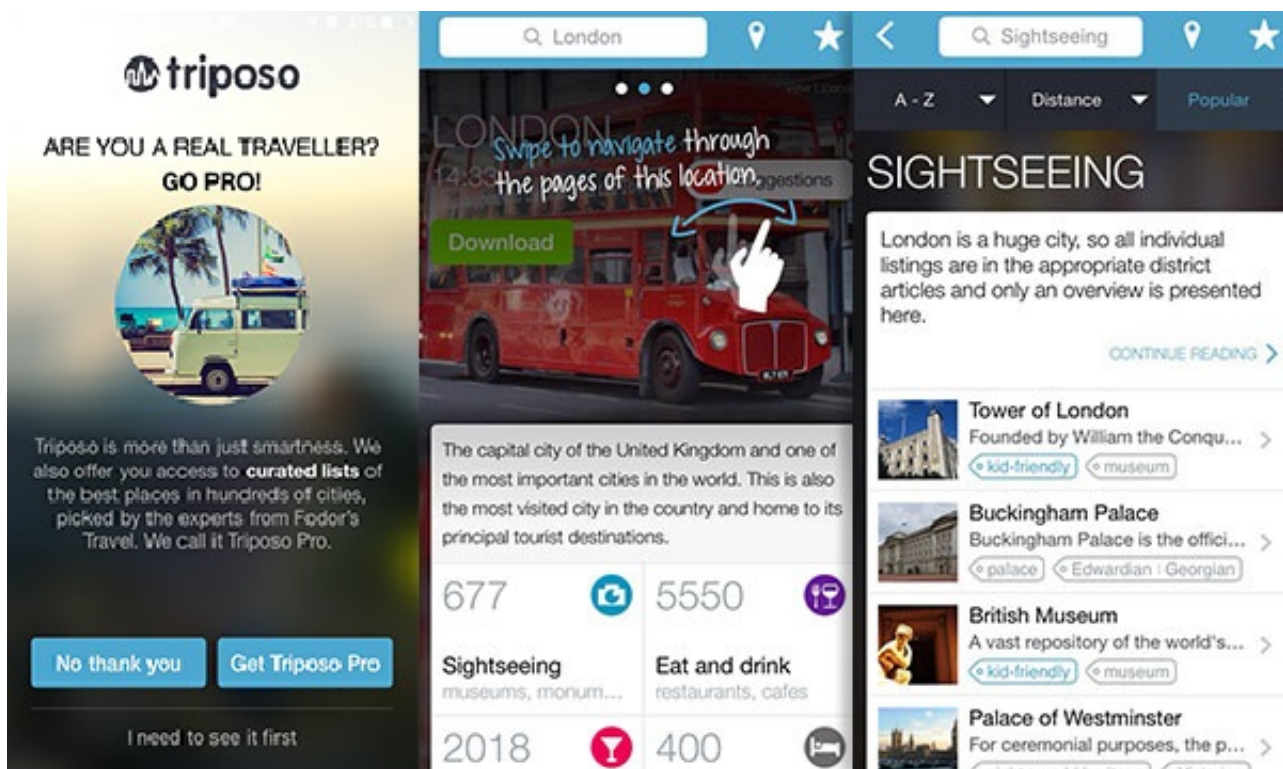

While traveling, there might be some places where the mobile signal doesn't work. But still, you can access your Google Trips offline. The app is available for Android and iOS, and free of charge.

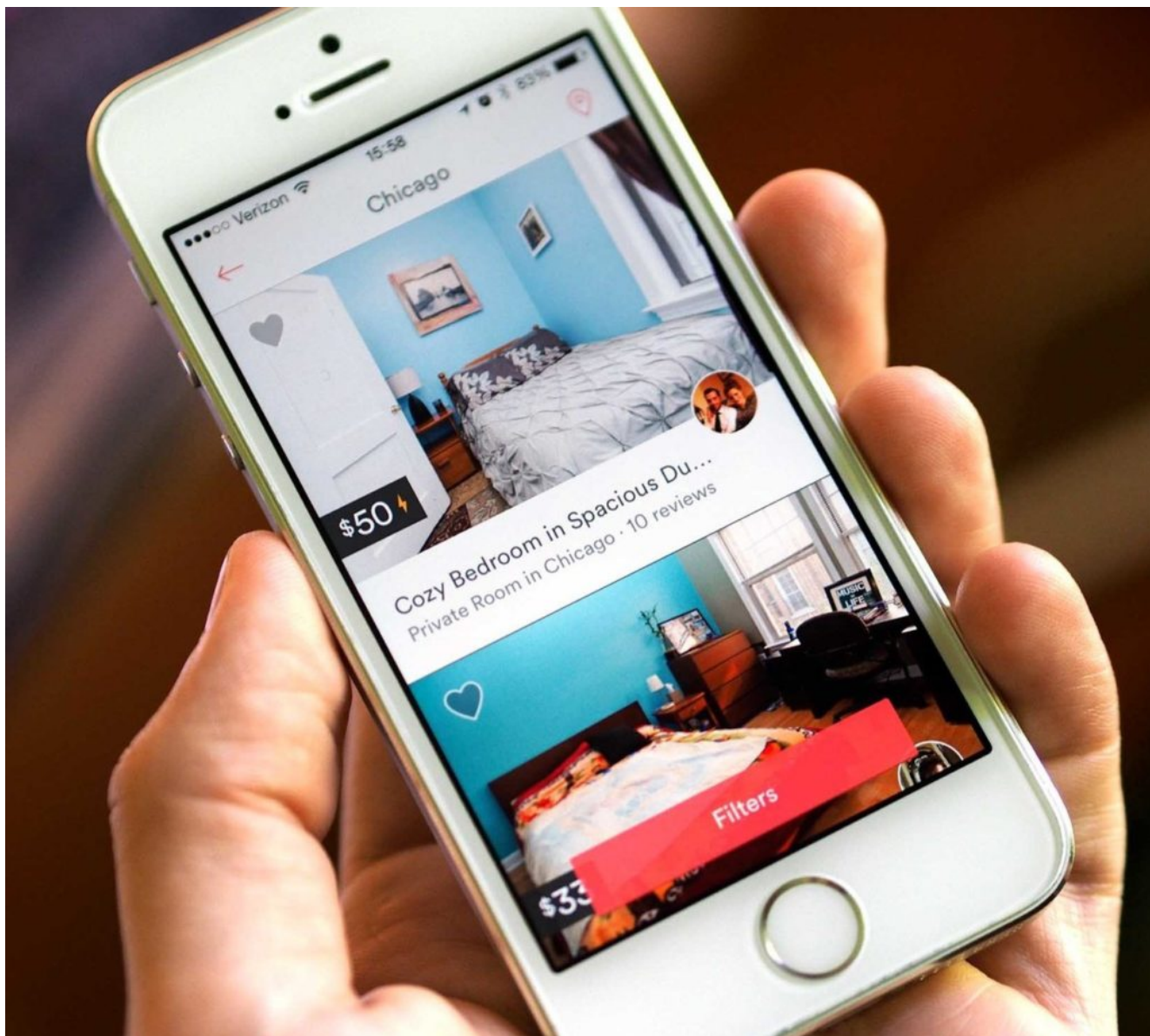
Airbnb
